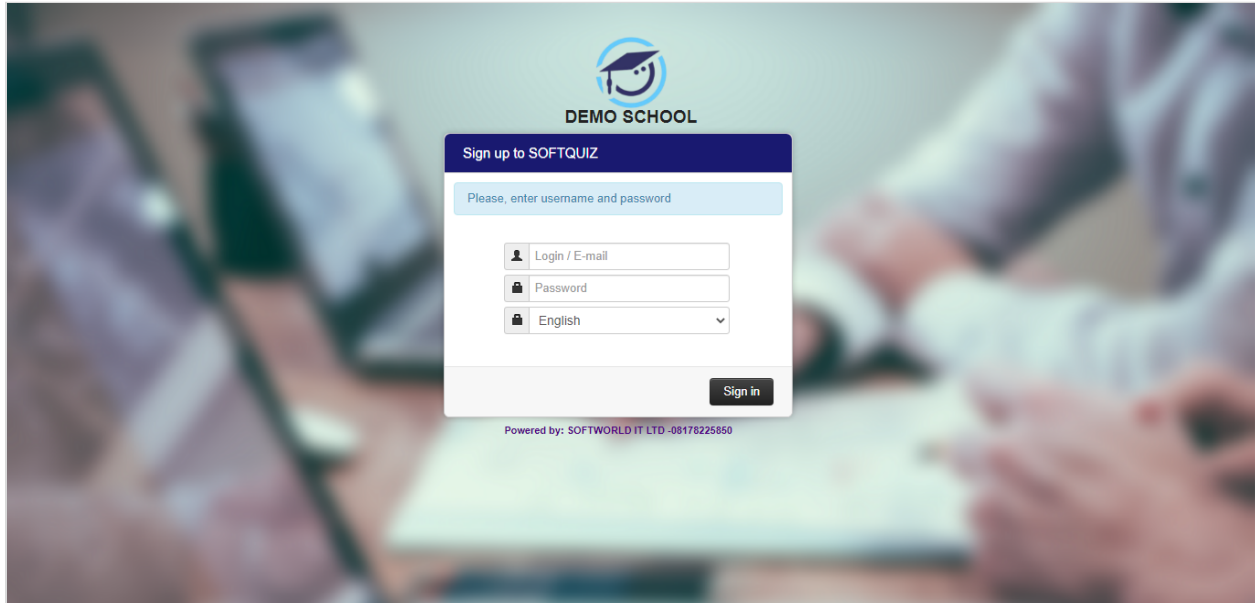

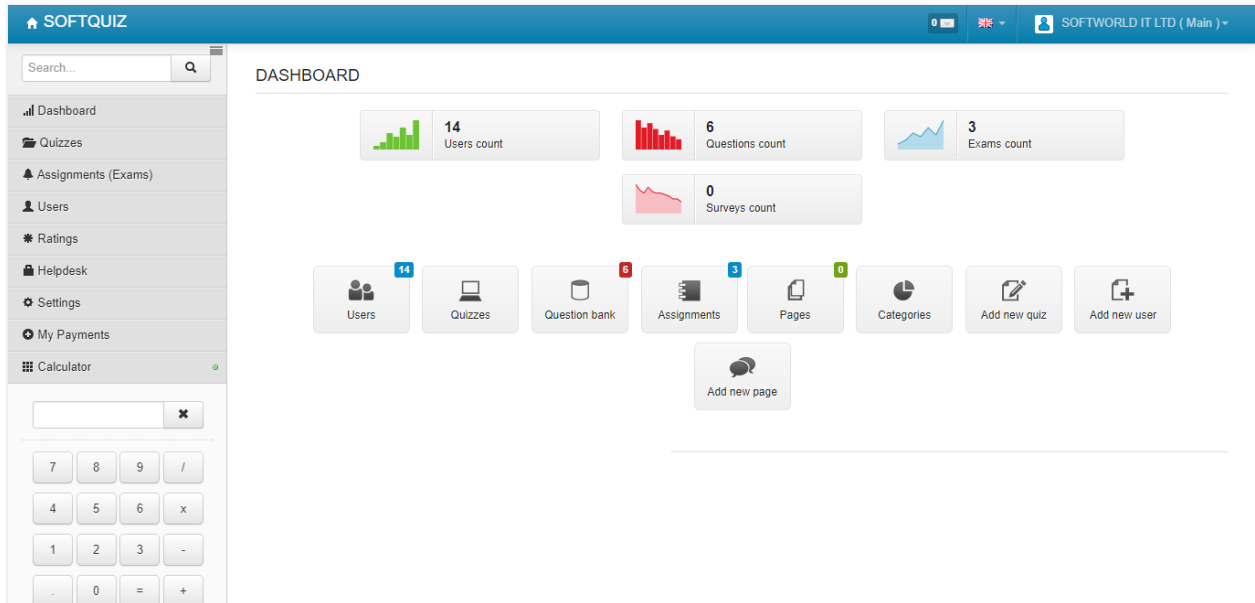

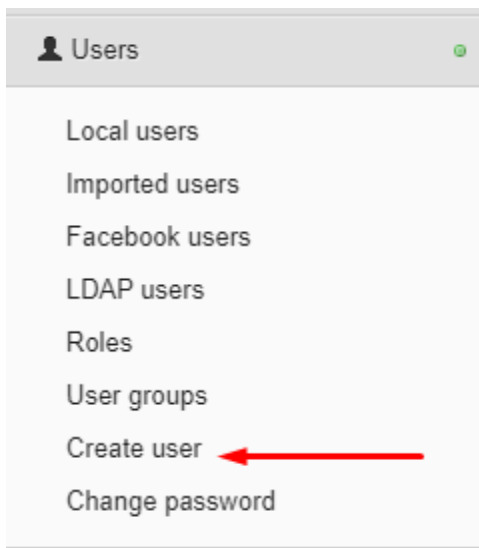

# DASHBOARD



SOFTQUIZ comes with a tentative administrative login details. These are **sysadmin** as the username and **sysadmin** as the password. The school's ICT administrator should login for the first time using these login details. After a successful login into the **DASHBOARD**, he/she can create a new administrative account and login details. This is done under the module **Users**.



Under module **User**, click **Create user**. A registration form will appear. The administrator should fill the form.

During the creation of an administrator’s account, the **User type(Role)** should be set to **System Administrator** and the User **Group** should be **Admin**. For teachers ‘accounts, System Examiner or the equivalent should be selected as the **User type** and **User Group** set to **Examiner**.

**Setting the User Type (Role)**

User Type setting makes the system distinguish between the users of this software. **System Administrator , Examiner and Candidate** are the default user type. The **Examiner** is a role of the teacher/lecturer/interviewer that manages the test questions. The **Candidate** is a role of the candidate that answers the questions from the Examiners. The Access Management link is a sensitive area that demands thorough understanding of system administrator in the use of this application. However, we have set it for default usage.

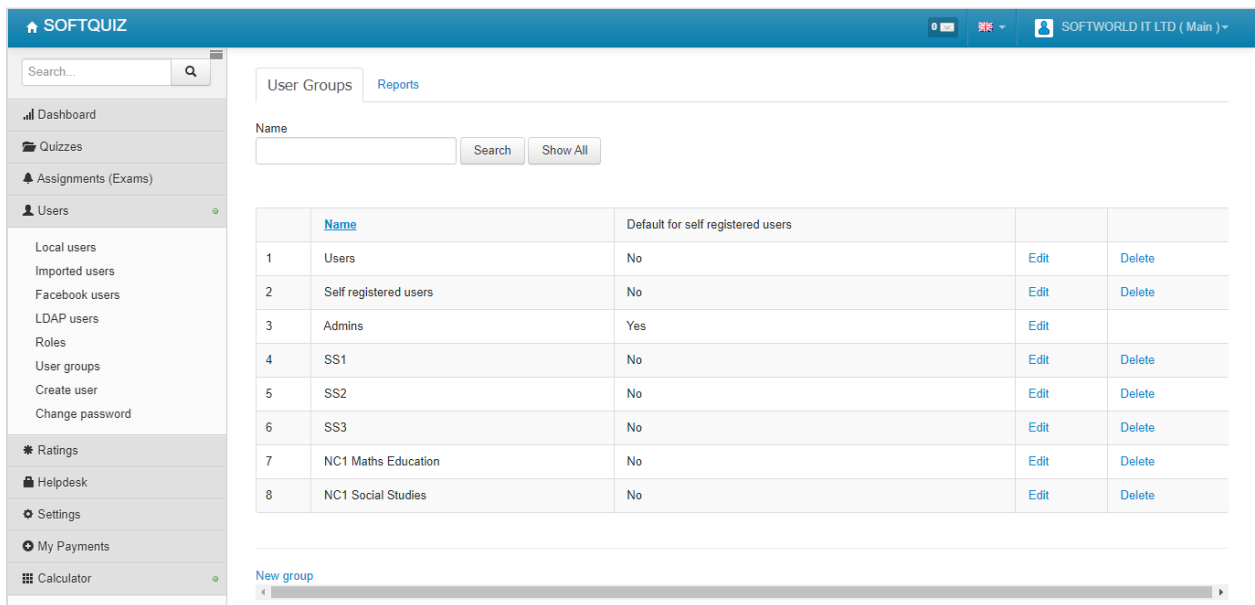

**User Group** is the classification of all the users particularly the candidates into batches. For example, the secondary school students could be grouped into

SS1,SS2,SS3 or SS1A,SS1B, SS2A , SS1 science, SS1 Art , SS1 Business etc. To the higher institution of learning, it could be 100L Mathematics,200L Mathematics,100L Business Administration etc Or NC1 Maths Edu, NC2 Maths Edu etc. Whichever way, the user group should be created in a way to allow the students for the same examination to be batched together. ## QUESTION CATEGORY

The first thing to take care of in the creation of questions is the question categories. It depends on the institution, category is used here to group the questions on termly or semester basis. For a secondary school, the category could be First Term, Second Term and Third Term. For higher institutions of learning, the category could be First Semester, Second Semester.

## Creating Quiz Name

Quiz name is like a group name for questions. Questions of the same course/subject can be grouped together under a Quiz name. For example, the 100L questions on Mathematics (say MAT 101) can be grouped under a Quiz name 100L MAT 101. Similarly NC1 questions under Education course( say EDU 234) can be grouped under NC1 EDU 234. For a secondary school, a Quiz name could be SS1 Mathematics. During the creation of a Quiz name, you must select a **Category** for the Quiz name. For example, you could select Category -First Semester/First Term for a Quiz name 100L MAT 101. This shows that MAT 101 questions are meant for 100L students. In case of carry-over or repetition , the concern candidates must be added on discretion of the school examiner.

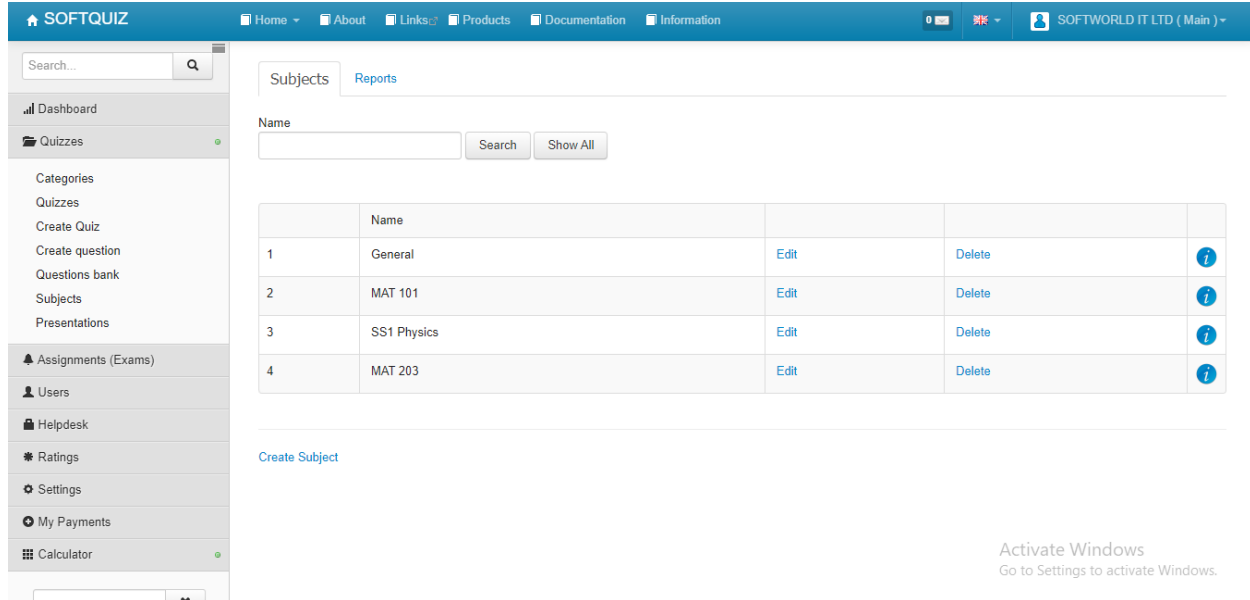
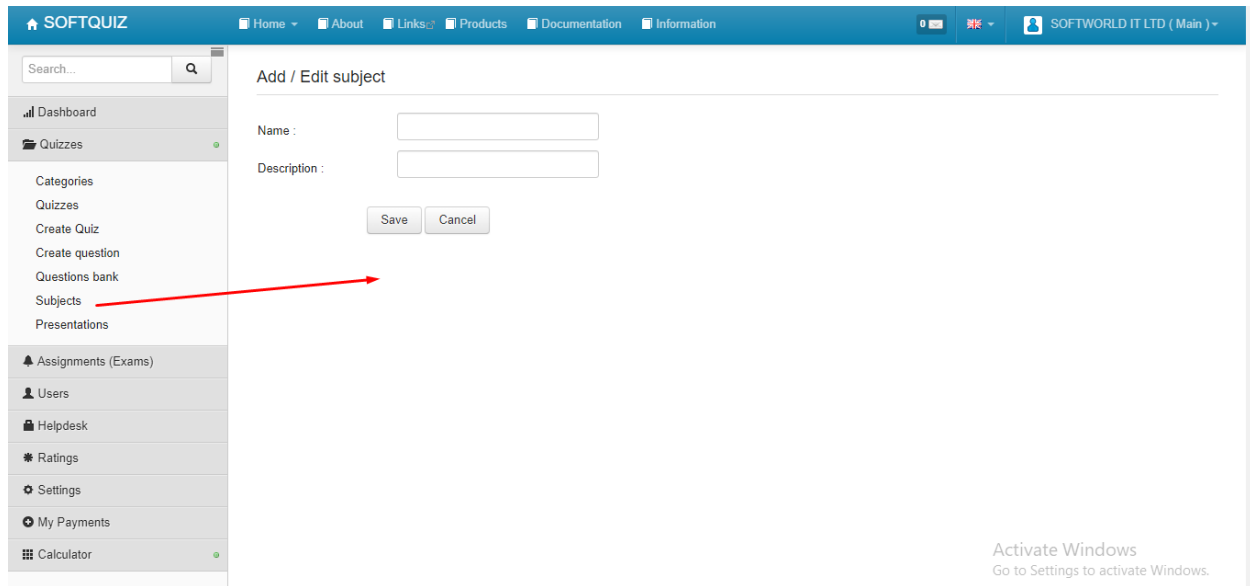

## Creating Subject Name/Course Code

The next is the creation of the subject name/ course title. This will appear on the examination page for the candidate. It is also needed when creating questions.





## Creation of Question

There are two ways to create questions.

1. Creation of questions directly into the question bank
2. Creation of questions under Quiz name

**Note:** For each of the two methods, there is a need to, first of all, create the subject name or the course code as applicable to the higher institution.

This name will appear to the candidate on the examination page.

## Creation of questions directly into the question bank

To create a question into the question bank, click **create question** under the module **Quizzes**.

### Steps:

- Select the appropriate subject name or course code
- Use the Rich-Text Editor to enter the questions. You can format, style, bold, color and give size using the tools. Place your cursor on the tools, the names of the tools will show.

- Set the question point and penalty point. You may leave the penalty point as 0 if there is no penalty for not getting the question's answer correctly.
- Header text is for any instruction necessary for the question. Question on English comprehension passage is an example. The passage can be pasted in the header text for a candidate to read before answering the question in concern. But Header and Footer text are optional.
- The footer text may also be used if the aim is that the instruction should come after the question.
- Question Type select control is used to choose the type of answer options aimed at the question. There are single-choice, multiple choice and free text. The single choice allows a candidate to choose a correct answer. A multiple-choice is for more than one correct answer. The free text type allows a question that demands a candidate to type in the answer in text using a keyboard.
- The final step is to input the choices in the **Answer Variant** boxes and check the correct answer. If you aim to give a different point to each answer for multiple-choice type of question, you can enter the points in the **Answer Point** boxes. **Answer Description** is for giving provision of description for the answer if it is necessary. Both **Answer Point and Answer Description are optional.**
- **Then submit the data**
- **NOTE: the plus + and Minus - buttons are used to add more Answer Variant or to reduce from the Answer Variants respectively**

To create questions under a Quiz name, create Quizzes to view the table of Quiz names already created. For each of the records, there is a column titled Questions. Once you click the link-Questions, you will be taken to the page where your questions can be typed under the chosen Quiz name.

## CREATING EXAMINATION (ASSIGNING EXAMINATION TO CANDIDATES)

All we have been doing so far must end with this stage. This is where a bundle of questions under a given Quiz Name is assigned to a set or batch of candidates to sit for. Under the module **Assignment(Exam)**, click **Create Assignment**. The first area to go is under the Tab - **General Settings**.

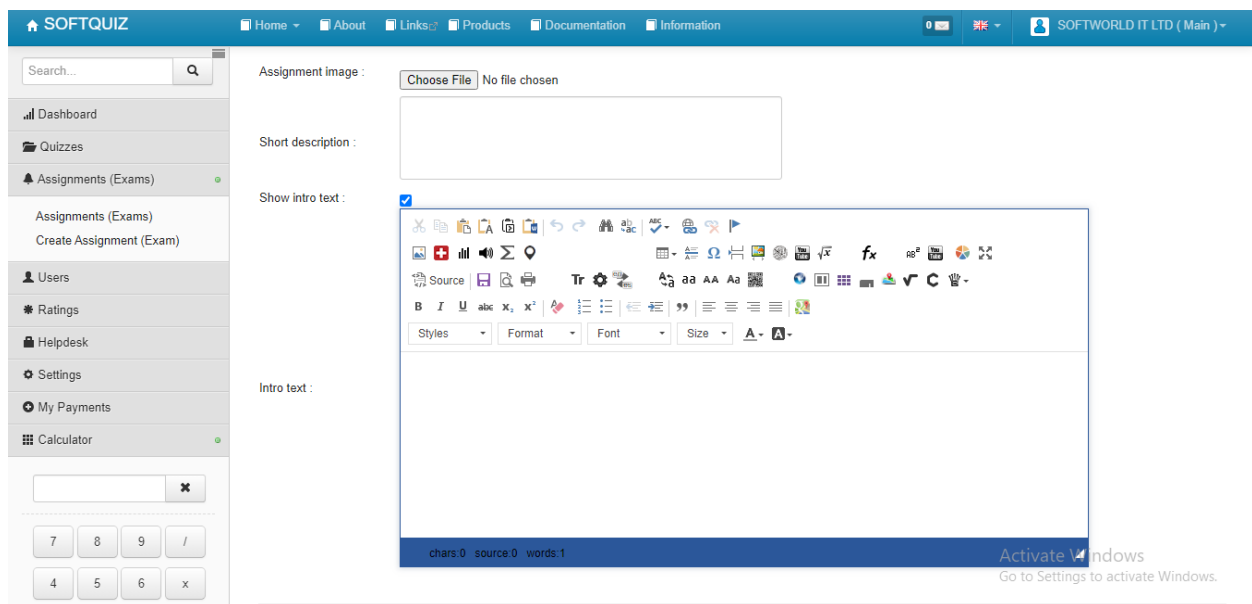
- ❖ **Assignment Name:** Title of the Examination. For example, 100L MAT102 , SS1 Physics etc
- ❖ **Category:** Select the Examination Category. Remember you must have created categories before you come over here. The Categories could be First Semester and Second Semester. Or it could be First Term , Second Term and Third Term.
- ❖ **Questions:** When a category is chosen, all the corresponding Quiz Names under it are loaded for selection. You can select any of the Quiz Names or you choose the Question **Bank** option to go and fetch your questions from the Question Bank. The Question Bank will showcase all the questions

under all the Quiz Names. So an Examiner can combine Questions from different Quiz Names together under a n Examination. The Examiner may choose from a single Quiz Name at random in the Question Bank.

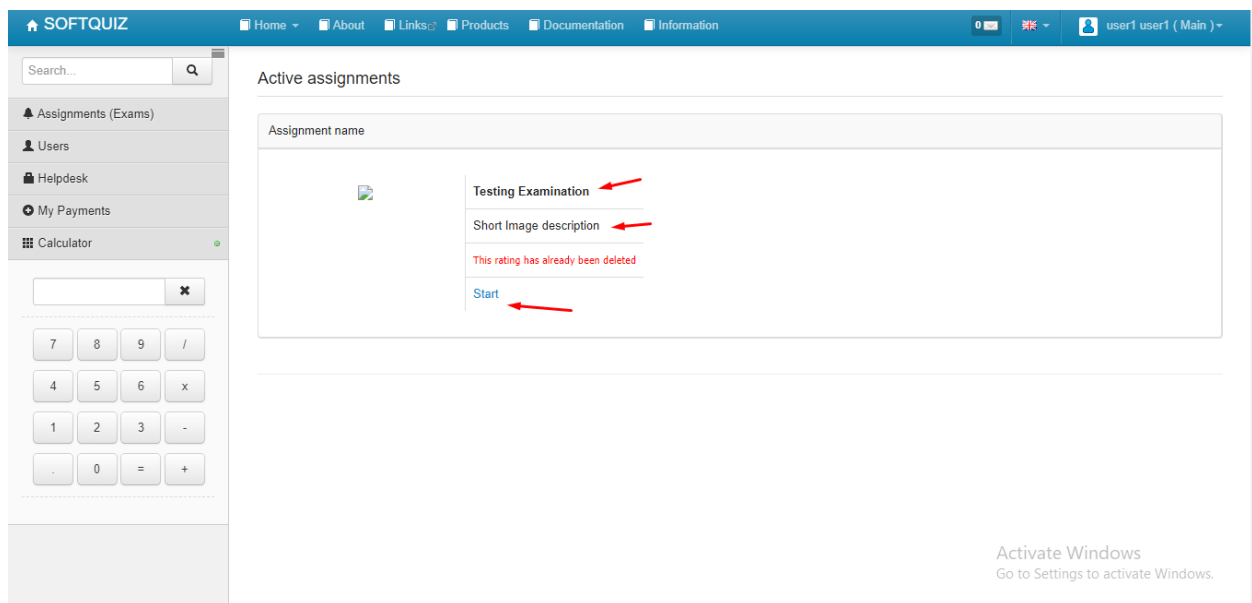
- ❖ **Examination Type**: This could be a Quiz or Survey. Choose the corresponding
- ❖ **Show questions** : It could be all the questions in a Quiz Name chosen above or Random Questions from a set of Quiz Name chosen above. If Random is selected. The questions set for each candidate come differently from the total Questions in the bank. The next two steps will be involved.
- ❖ **>Show random questions** : Enter the random amount from Total or from a subject/course.
- ❖ **>Variants** : Select number of different copies of questions set . If 5 is selected, five copies of question sets are generated from the Quiz name. Each is pushed to a candidate at random. A copy of the question set sent to Candidate A might not be sent to candidate B.
- ❖ **Calculate by** : Point or Percentage
- ❖ **Success point/percent** : determined by the Examiner
- ❖ **Test time (in minutes)** : determined by the Examiner
- ❖ **Number of attempts** : determined by the Examiner
- ❖ **Results template** : Select Standard
